

We were delighted to welcome 42 people to West Heath Nursery School for our second Early Year's Network meeting. Sandra Williams (Early Years Consultant) and Jo Taylor (Frankley Plus Children's Centre) gave a brief introduction to the **Designated Safeguarding Leader Activity (DSL A)**. Susan Worgan gave Feedback from the network steering group meeting. Andrew Cull (a representative from 2simple) gave a short presentation about the 2simple app which can be used to document children's learning to support planning and assessment in early years settings. There were plenty of opportunities to reflect together and share practice from different settings enabling us to consider why we do what we do; helping us to improve our everyday practice.

A brief overview of sessions planned for this meeting:

Right Service Right Time

An informative presentation explaining Birmingham Safeguarding Children Board's Right Service Right Time model. We will look at 'My agency's responsibilities', 'What constitutes a good referral' and 'What happens next after a referral has been made.'

Supporting communication and language in the Early Years

An introduction to the WellComm toolkit; a simple assessment framework which can be used to screen and monitor children's Communication and Language Development. Followed an opportunity for settings to share how they assess, monitor and support children's Communication and Language Development.

Jane Taylor—Information for settings about the 2yr check

Jane will give a presentation explaining changes to the way in which 2 year old development checks will be carried out. The changes will mean that a child's key person, health visitor and parents / carers will work together to complete the checks.

Teresa Johnson—Startwell

Teresa will be available to offer help and support to settings working towards the Level One Startwell Award. Settings will be able to share their ideas and offer support to one another.
